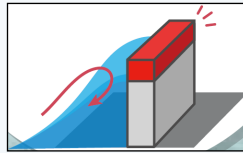

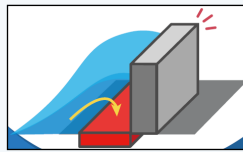
Tsunami prevention for your safety & peace of mind

In order to protect lives and the city from tsunamis caused by earthquakes, Kobe City has been strengthening tsunami prevention measures since 2015. These measures were completed at the end of March 2023, and they are among the best in Japan.

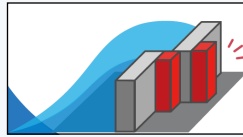
Stronger seawalls



① Seawall heights are raised to prevent seawater from splashing over the edge.



② The seawall foundation has been fortified with concrete to prevent destruction from a tsunami.



③ The joints have been fortified to prevent seawater from pouring through the gaps.

Disaster prevention using the latest technology



① Remote operation of storm surge gates via tablet



② Real-time cameras

The open-close status of storm surge gates and sea level height can be monitored in real-time.

Up to ¥950,000 in subsidies for young couples & families with children to relocate!

This subsidy can be used to buy a used house, move into a rental unit, or have a new family move close to the parents.

Eligibility: Households that meet either of the following conditions

- ◆ Young married couple (combined age of 80 years or less)
- ◆ Household with children

How to apply: e-KOBE (Kobe City smart online application system)

Application acceptance period:

June 1, 2023 - March 31, 2024, or until the budget is used

Get regular cancer screenings

Cancer is a disease that can be cured 90% of the time if detected in its early stages. If you get a cancer screening at a hospital/clinic designated by Kobe City, you can do so for a very small copay (500 - 2,000 yen).

Eligibility & Screening Types

20 y.o. & up: Cervical cancer (women, even years)

40 y.o. & up: Colon cancer, stomach cancer (barium test), lung cancer, breast cancer (women, even years)

50 y.o. & up (even years): Stomach cancer (endoscopic exam)

Do not release invasive species into the wild



If you have non-native animals as pets:

- Losing them outside, or releasing them into the wild, is prohibited
- Make sure they can't escape into the wild
- If you can no longer care for them, please consult with Kobe City

***It is now illegal to release these pets into the wild**

Commuter pass subsidy for senior high school students



To ease the burden on families with children, Kobe City will subsidize the portion of a commuter pass for senior high school students which exceeds a certain amount.

Application period: January 4 - April 12, 2024

Eligible period: April 1, 2023 - March 31, 2024

Subsidy amount: If the student is a resident of Kobe, and their commuter pass value for the eligible period exceeds 144,000 yen, the subsidy will cover 1/2 of that excess
